

Who We Are

Homecoming 250 Navy Marine Corps is a 501(c)(3) charitable organization dedicated to bringing the celebration of the U.S. Navy and U.S. Marine Corps 250th birthdays to their birthplace - Philadelphia and the Delaware River. The Navy and Marine Corps were created in Independence Hall and Congress Hall, organized at Tun Tavern, and launched their first ships and amphibious missions from the Delaware in Fall 1775. There is no better place to celebrate their 250th anniversaries.

Homecoming 250™ has won tremendous support. The Secretary of the Navy has directed the Navy and Marine Corps to celebrate the Navy and Marine Corps 250th in Philadelphia and Camden in 2025, and to prepare by having a Navy/Marine Corps Week in both cities on October 9-15, 2023. Homecoming 250 is honored to serve as the charitable coordinating body, working with the Armed Services and cities.

In Fall 2025, Homecoming 250 is planning to celebrate the 250th anniversary of the Navy and Marine Corps with spectacular events that could only happen here. We will host the 100th Marine Corps Ball in Philadelphia where the 1st Marine Corps Ball was held in 1925. We plan to celebrate near the site where Tun Tavern once stood, and are working to re-create Tun Tavern just a short walk away.

This amazing celebration will be the grand opening event of America's Semiquincentennial and one of the biggest events honoring those who serve.
